  - Southbound: West Old Town Road to Route 43
  - Eastbound: Route 221 will be inaccessible from Hudson Hill/Darling Roads, (Until the parade has passed the intersection of Hudson Hill Road and RTR 221, Then Southbound access to RTE 221 will be available as well as Westbound traffic on Hudson Hill Road) use of either Northbound or Southbound detours will gain access to points North and South of the Parade Route.
