

**BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING

MINUTES**

I. OPEN MEETING

- Members Present- N. Veazie, M. Kelley, Jay Grover, D. Gray and R. Gray

II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- May 4, 2026 Meeting Minutes- M. Kelley made a motion to accept the minutes as written. R. Gray 2nd the motion. Discussion- None. Vote- 5-0.
- May 18, 2026, 2026 Meeting Minutes- M. Kelley made a motion to accept the minutes as written. R. Gray 2nd the motion. Discussion- None. Vote- 5-0.

III. BOARD OF ASSESSORS/MUNICIPAL OFFICERS

- **a. Adjustments to agenda-** R. Gray added g. Reforestation. J. Grover added Executive Session 1 M.R.S.A § 405 (6)(C).
- **b. Correspondence-** J. Williams went over correspondence
- **c. Warrant Signing-** N. Veazie went over the AP/Payroll warrants. R. Gray made a motion to accept as written. M. Kelley 2nd the motion. Discussion- None. Vote- 5-0.
- **d. Use of Building for Co-Op** – The Board received an email request to use two classrooms and the gym on Fridays for a weekly co-op program serving approximately 16 children. N. Veazie stated that the facility does not currently have two available classrooms to accommodate the request. Board members also noted that a similar request had been made previously and was denied. The Board agreed that approving the current request would be inconsistent with that prior decision and would not be fair.

- **Scholarship-** D. Miles stated the Scholarship Committee will be holding there annual bake sale on Election Day which will be held June 9th, 2026.
- **Rec Dept-** J. Grover stated they found a Summer Program Director out of Brewer. He also Stated the Rec Meeting scheduled for June 15, 2026 has been moved to Wednesday, June 17th, 2026 at 6:30 PM.

- **a. Thurston's Way/Wilder Davis RD-** R. Gray explained that the occupants have been removed from Wilder Davis Rd and it has been locked up. The board discussed moving forward with the original plan of the 80k Action. R. Gray also was going to get more info on funding.

- **b. Use of building Policy/Application Amendment-** D. Gray explained the revisions to the building Use Policy and Application. M. Kelley made a motion to accept the revisions made by the Policy Committee. J. Grover 2nd the motion. Discussion- None. Vote- 5-0

VIII. EXECUTIVE SESSION

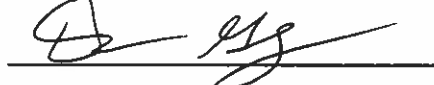
