

**BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING
TOWN OF HUDSON
MONDAY, JUNE 15, 2026
MINUTES**

I. OPEN MEETING

- N. Veazie opened the meeting at 6:00 PM
- Members Present- N. Veazie, M. Kelley, R. Gray, and D. Gray

II. BOARD OF ASSESSORS/MUNICIPAL OFFICERS

- a. **Warrant** — N. Veazie reviewed the Accounts Payable and Payroll Warrants. M. Kelley made a motion to accept the warrants as written. R. Gray 2nd the motion.
- b. **Select Board-** The board signed the Roadside mowing contract.

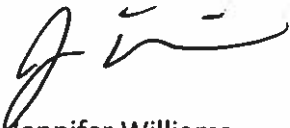
III. NEW BUSINESS

- **Maintenance-** N. Veazie reported that an excessive number of stumps have been coming into the Transfer Station, and the Town does not have the equipment necessary to bury them. Options discussed included establishing a fee to cover the cost of hiring an outside party to bury the stumps or finding an alternative solution. D. Gray stated he did not know why the Town had resumed accepting stumps, as the practice had previously been discontinued. D. Gray made a motion to stop accepting stumps effective immediately. R. Gray seconded the motion. Discussion- None. Vote- 4-0.
- D. Gray explained that B. Storman is in need of another person. B. Storman had spoken to S. Sabine and he would be willing to work 20 hrs a week. D. Gray said he is comfortable with B. Storman managing the hours and schedule as he needed. D. Gray made a motion to hire S. Sabine for 20 hours per week at the rate of \$16.00 per hour, effective upon a meeting between N. Veazie, B. Storman and S. Sabine. R. Gray 2nd the motion. Discussion- None. Vote- 4-0.
- **QuitClaim Deed-** K. Gray reported that the resident at 26 Log Cabin Drive has paid the Land Purchase Agreement in full. The Board reviewed and signed the Quitclaim Deed, returning full ownership of the property to the resident.

- M. Kelley made a motion to adjourn at 6:20 PM. D. Gray 2nd the motion. Discussion- None. Vote- 4-0.

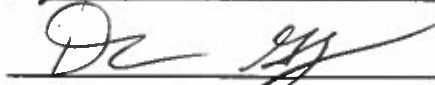
