**I. OPEN MEETING**

**II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Gray made a motion to establish a warrant article. To see if the town will raise and appropriate \$5,000 for the **Town of Hudson's 200<sup>th</sup> Year Celebration**. This is to get funding started for the 2025 celebration. A board/committee will be formed to begin planning. (This will be a carry forward account.) ( \$5,000 recommended by the Select Board from Fund Balance). M. Kelley 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Discussion- None. Vote-4-0.
- **b. A. Murphy- Hudson Recreation Outdoor Group-** A. Murphy is interested in starting an outdoor group for the kids of Hudson and surrounding towns. This group would be outdoor based for survival and safety. It would include basic first aid, CPR/first aid training, fire starting/safety, navigating with a compass, emergency shelter, hunters safety, fishing, weather preparation, and etc. This would also include a camping trip. D. Gray thought this was a great idea and suggested she email Kristin Goddard to get the activity moving forward.
- **c. Website Committee-** R. Gray would like to get volunteers who are interested in starting a website committee to work on updating the website. He would like to see the younger generation involved. D. Gray thought this was a great idea.

- **b. Selectmen-** K. Gray questioned where the payment for the security installation is coming from. The Board agreed it would come out of the ARPA Fund.

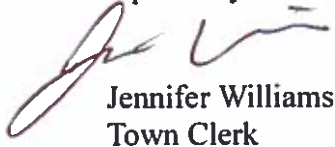
## VIII. EXECUTIVE SESSION
